

## **Zambia: Uranium for Energy**

The Energy Regulation Board says Zambia should exploit possibilities of using Uranium for nuclear energy.

Director of Infrastructure and operations, Kenneth Kangende said Zambia has uranium deposits in North Western province which can be used to generate nuclear energy.

Mr. Kangende said this in Lusaka, when the ERB launched standards for lubricant dealers in Zambia.

He said the country can also export the Uranium to Europe and South America where nuclear energy is being used.

Mr. Kangende however noted the need to develop a policy on the use of nuclear energy.
